### Outreach Ministry

- Thanks to the generous response of the SHPC congregation PC-USA will have \$2000 in additional funds to support their mission work both here at home and around the world. The money donated to the One Great Hour of Sharing supports the Self-Development of People Program, the Presbyterian Disaster Assistance Fund, and the Presbyterian Hunger Program.
- The Outreach Ministry team is sponsoring a collection of baby diapers and baby wipes. The items can be brought to worship on April 22 and 29th. The donated items will be distributed between Avalon and the Latino community. Avalon provides emergency shelter to women and children who often come with only the clothes on their back. They have no funds for diapers and baby wipes which are needed daily. Women in the Latino Network will receive contributions through Children's Development Resources. They hold monthly well-baby sessions and the women who bring their babies will welcome a gift of diapers and baby wipes.
